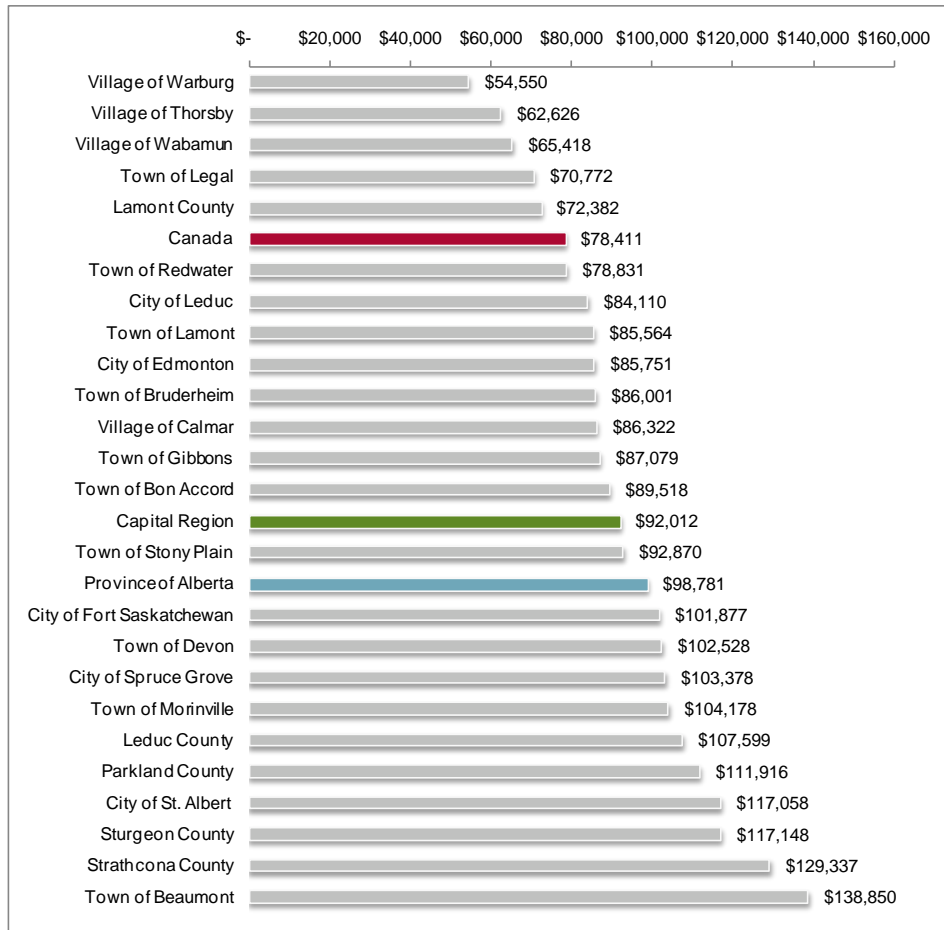


3.2 Socio-economic Indicators

Household Income

Figure 3.6 below shows that there is considerable variation in average incomes among municipalities in the Capital Region in 2010. County residents (Strathcona, Sturgeon, Parkland and Leduc Counties) tend to have considerably higher household incomes than residents of other municipalities. The City of St. Albert and the Town of Beaumont also exhibit relatively high average incomes. In contrast, the more rural areas show much lower average household incomes. Residents of the Village of Warburg have household incomes less than half those of Strathcona County. Overall, average household incomes in the Capital Region are about seven percent below the provincial average, but fully 20 percent above the average for Canada.
